2009 Australian RS Classes Championships

24th-26th of January 2009 at Woollahra Sailing Club,
Vickery Avenue, Rose Bay. Sydney**



1 Organising Authority and Venue

The organising authority and venue for the regatta is Woollahra Sailing Club, Vickery Avenue, Rose Bay.

2 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2011) the special regulations of Yachting Australia, the rules of the RS Classes (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

3 Alterations of Racing Rules

The racing rules will be modified in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

Rule 44.1, taking a Penalty is altered to read: "A boat that may have broken a rule of part 2 while racing may take a penalty at the time of her incident. Her penalty shall be a 360°Turn Penalty".

4 Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Brand. All sailors must also be member of a Yachting Australia affiliated club.

4.2 Eligible boats can enter on the attached Entry Form which shall be lodged with:

Entries must be received by 9.00 on 17th of January 2009 at Woollahra Sailing Club and must be accompanied by the required fee.

5 Fees

Regatta Entry: \$190.00 and may be paid by Credit, Cheque or Cash.

7 Measurements

Measurement is not required but each boat shall comply to its RS classes measurement rules.

8 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available during registration at Woollahra Sailing Club.

9 Racing Area

The racing area shall be on the waters of Sydney Harbour, South of the Sow and Pigs Reef and East the harbour bridge.

10 Courses

The courses shall be windward/leeward courses as described in the sailing instructions.

11 Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply.

12 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the race committee
